Post: Music Minister

Purpose:To coordinate the musical activities across the church and enhance our calling

to be a vibrant, missional and multi-generation Christian community. We worship God who is Father, Son and Holy Spirit, living our daily lives as worship

and sharing our faith with Ecclesall and beyond.

To lead and equip an extensive group of volunteers to provide worship music

both choral led and band led at multiple services on a Sunday and occasionally

in the week.

Accountable to: The Associate Vicar & PCC

Responsible for: Organists, volunteer choir secretary, band service representatives

To work closely with the Vicar, Associate Vicar, Curate, Families Minister,

Relationships: Youth Minister, Operations Manager, the Office and Estate Teams, the

Churchwardens, and other All Saints volunteers.

Aim

- To attend and participate in weekly team meeting and in the work of the whole staff team
- To bring creativity, training and innovation to all areas of music in the church
- To grow the number of people who volunteer in this area of church life.
- To lead and or participate in the worship of at least one of the band-led services per week.
- To coordinate contemporary, band led worship. This will involve managing rotas, run basic training, leading bands and being a musician in volunteer led bands.
- To oversee (with the Youth Minister) the Youth led band who lead one evening service a month. To develop and encourage the musicians to lead this service.
- To provide leadership and conducting for the choir of the 9.15 service including leading the weekly Friday evening rehearsal with the choir and occasional other training opportunities.
- To choose music and hymns for the 9.15 service with the choir core team
- To coordinate with numerous classical musicians week to week this will mainly be organists
 and pianists but for special services there are many other musicians who can be brought
 together. For example, there have been small orchestras at Christmas and quartets on
 Sundays. There is a desire to utilise these musicians more in the future and build up the
 groups.
- To maintain a safe environment and ensure that all safeguarding policies are implemented using Safer Recruitment policies and Safer Working Practice. You must also undertake all relevant Diocese training events renewed each three years.
